





The APSSDC and DNR CE, Bhimavaram which is selected for technical Skill Development Institute (t-SDI) have mutually discussed and agreed to enter into this agreement as detailed hereinafter.

8 BREACH OF AGREEMENT& REMEDIAL PERIOD

In case the DNR CE, Bhimavaram, commits breach of any condition as laid down in this Agreement, the state level approval committee and/or government shall bring the same to the notice of DNR CE, Bhimavaram. In case the breach is not rectified within 30 days from the date of notice, as per the terms and spirit of this Agreement, APSSDC/ GoAP is authorized to take over the technical Skill Development Institute (t-SDI) along with the assets of the project and other fixed assets, except other liabilities of promoters and their employees.

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9. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The parties recognize that in the course of providing the software and performing the services pursuant to this Agreement, all parties may have access to confidential information and trade secrets belonging to the other and each Party desires that such confidential information and trade secrets remain confidential. Each party agrees that all confidential information and trade secrets communicated to the other in any manner (the "Confidential Information"), will be used by the recipient party only for the purposes allowed by this Agreement. The other party's Confidential Information will not be disclosed by the recipient party. other than to its employees. Each party will advise its employees and, shall sign confidential agreement with those who receive any of the other party's Confidential Information. The confidentiality provisions of this Section will not apply to any Confidential Information that (i) was or becomes generally available to the public other than as a result of disclosure by the recipient party in violation of this Agreement; (ii) becomes available to the recipient party from a source other than the other party, provided that the recipient party has no reason to believe that such source is itself bound by a confidentiality or nondisclosure agreement with the other party or otherwise prohibited from disclosing such Confidential Information by a legal, contractual or fiduciary obligation; (iii) was in the recipient party's possession prior to receipt from the other party; (iv) is independently developed by the recipient party without the use of the other party's Confidential Information; or (v) is required to be disclosed by the recipient party by a governmental agency or law, so long as the recipient party provides the other party with written notice of the required disclosure promptly upon receipt of notice of the required disclosure. Upon demand, the parties shall comply with each other's instructions regarding the disposition or return of the Confidential Information in its possession or control.

Upon any actual or threatened violation of this Section by either party, the other party will have the right, in addition to such other remedies which may be available to it, to seek injunctive relief enjoining such acts or attempts, it being acknowledged and agreed that monetary damages are inadequate to protect the S. 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10. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Except as agreed and provided under this Agreement, neither of the Parties shall be liable to bear or pay any damages arising out of loss of income, loss of profit, special, incidental, indirect, punitive, exemplary or consequential, to any party including third parties, and all such damages are expressively disclaimed.

11. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The Parties shall endeavor to resolve all or any dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, amicably within 30 days of notice in writing being issued by the non-defaulting party to the defaulting party indicating such dispute or difference. In case no amicable solution is arrived between the Parties within the said 30 days, then such dispute/s shall be settled through Arbitration as per the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. In such event, APSSDC shall nominate one arbitrator and DNR CE, Bhimavaram shall jointly nominate one arbitrator and these two arbitrators shall choose the third arbitrator. The written award of the majority arbitrators shall be final and binding on all the Parties. The seat and venue for the arbitration proceedings shall be Vijayawada/Amaravati, Andhra Pradesh.

12. FORCE MAJEURE

If the performance of any part of this Agreement by parties is prevented or delayed by acts of civil or military authority, flood, fire, epidemic, war or not, or other acts beyond the reasonable control of either party, the party affected shall be excused from such performance only during the continuance of any such event.

Where a Party is claiming suspension of its obligations on account of Force Majeure, it shall promptly, but in no case later than five (5) days after the occurrence of the event of Force Majeure, notify the other Party in writing giving full particulars of the Force Majeure, the estimated duration thereof, the obligations affected and the reasons for its suspension.

The Party asserting the claim of Force Majeure shall have the burden of proving that the circumstances constitute valid grounds of Force Majeure under this

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clause and that such Party has exercised reasonable diligence and efforts to remedy the cause of any alleged Force Majeure. If the parties are unable in good faith agree that a Force Majeure event has occurred, the Parties shall submit the dispute for resolution pursuant to clause 11 hereof provided that the burden of proof as to whether a Force Majeure event has occurred shall be upon the Party claiming a Force Majeure event.



ORDER:

- 1. As part of the Vision 2029, the Government of Andhra Pradesh has the ambitious plan of being one of top three developed States of the Country within the next five years. As envisaged in the G.O. first cited seven different missions have been formed to prioritize and energize main sectors of growth. "Knowledge and Skills Mission" occupies an important position in order to develop the employable skilled work force in the State of Andhra Pradesh as well as in India.
- 2. In the G.O. 2nd read above, the Government has issued orders creating Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation. Ever since APSSDC has been at the forefront of all skilling activities in the State and has been tirelessly scouring new and innovative areas of expertise and high end technology partners to tap the vast human capital potential in the State with its
 - emphasis on empowering the youth. The Corporation in its 3rd Board Meeting held on 13.12.2014 decided to depute a team to visit the SIEMENS Centers of Excellence already established in Gujarat and submit a report. Accordingly, the team has visited the SIEMENS Centers in Gujarat, conducted a detailed study of centers and submitted a report.
- SIEMENS Industry Software Company has been in India since 1980. It has been offering training
 programmes in collaboration with various State Governments. Government of Andhra Pradesh has also
 had detailed discussions with SIEMENS Company in order to accomplish the goal of Knowledge and
 Skill Mission. A comprehensive presentation was made to the Government on
 - 9th February, 2015 about the Skill Development and Training activities being impacted by SIEMENS and their intent in Collaborating with the Government of Andhra Pradesh as was done in Gujarat and their contribution to the economy of the State by the establishment of SIEMENS centers of excellence, Technical Skill Development Institutions and Skill Development Centers. Further, the Government has decided that—

- (a) A Cluster comprising (1) Center of Excellence (COE) and (5) Technical Skill Development Institutions (TSDIs) and skill development centers (SDCs) would be established at a cost of Rs. 546,84,18,908/- with SIEMENS and Design Tech providing grant-in-aid of Rs. 491,84,18,908/- (90%) and Government share being Rs. 55,00,00,000/- (10%).
- (b) To establish six SIEMENS clusters each costing Rs. 546.84 erore with the Government contribution being limited to 10% of the cost.
- 4. It has been decided by the Government for the sanction of an amount of Rs. 370,78,80,000/- for the project for establishing of (6) such clusters distributed throughout the State. For the 3rd year of agreement, the Centers will be handed over to the joint operational control of APSSDC and hosting institution, with appropriate overseeing and hand holding by SEIMENS and Design Tech. However, the costs of trainers and equipment maintenance will continue to be borne by SEIMENS and Design Tech for the third year.
- 5. Government has also decided vide G.O.3rd read above for the establishing of new department of Skill Development, Entrepreneurship and Innovation (SDEI) with the Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC) as its implementing (HoD) agency. Accordingly, the department of SDEI requested the APSSDC, its implementing agency to take further action in the matter and initiate appropriate action to implement the Siemens project and send the action taken report to Government in the matter.
- 6. In the letter 4th read above, the Chief Executive Officer, APSSDC has sent a letter dated 22nd June, 2015 asking for permission to get into an agreement with SIEMENS and Design Tech and also for the sanction of grant as decided by the Government in order to implement the project. The Chief Executive Officer, A.P. State Skill Development Corporation has also submitted the documents to be signed by APSSDC, SIEMENS and Design Tech in this regard.
- 7. After careful examination, the Government hereby accord permission for entering into Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and A.P. State Skill Development Corporation for an amount of Rs. 370,78,80,000/-(Three Seventy Crore Seventy Eight Lakh Eighty Thousand) towards 10% of cost of the Project from the current year's budget allocation with 90% being met by the grant from Technology Partners.
- The Managing Director & Chief Executive Officer, AP State Skill Development Corporation shall take further necessary action in the matter.

In the reference 3rd read above, i.e., on 16-02-2016, during the Selection Committee meeting for Selection of Centers for the "Andhra Pradesh- Skill Development Project" in the form of hubspoke model is explained Six clusters were defined. These are territorial region roughly consisting of two three district. They have been defined based on the supply side information in terms of population, number of institutions, and capacity of those institutions. Alignment of the clusters has been made with the proposed industrial development while keeping district also as a geographical unit. Each cluster will be one Centre of Excellence (COE) and five Technical Skill Development Institutes (TSDI)

- 6. Further, as decided by the committee, all the hosting institutions need to be inspected by a team of experts. Accordingly, teams have been constituted comprising members from Technical Education Department, Central Institute of Tools and Design, Hyderabad (an autonomous organization under Office of Government of India) and Jawaharlal Nehru Technological Universities (JNTUs), Kakinada and Anantapur to inspections have been carried out and inspection reports have been submitted.
- 7. Suitable criteria fixed for evaluation of the institutions and accordingly all the applications were graded and Universities and Engineering Colleges were evaluated using one set of criteria and also Polytechnics restricted one set of criteria. The ranked list of universities/colleges/institutions by Polytechnics restricted one set of criteria. The ranked list of universities/colleges/institutions by Polytechnical has been prepared and they have been evaluated with reference to the prescribed criteria, cluster/district has been prepared and they have been evaluated with reference to the prescribed criteria. Finally, the committee constituted for the purpose of evaluation has recommended and approved the Colleges' Institutions' Organizations as Centre of Excellence (COE)/Technical Skill Development Institutions (TSDIs).
- The Government after careful examination comprehensively, hereby orders that the institutions/ organizations/Universities as shown in the Annexure are selected as Siemens Centers of Excellence (6) Technical Skill Development Institutions (36) subject to the following conditions:-
 - That the institutions will be subjected to further inspection by a team comprising members from SIEMENS and Design Tech.
 - If found unsuitable due to restrictions and place, ability to accommodate 50% of capacity to outsiders, residential facilities to outsiders, another suitable institution, satisfying the conditions will be substituted.


