- Provides appropriate emotional & psychological support to the victims in the form of counseling, security.

Student members

- Receive the complaints of sexual harassment.
- Initiate the inquiry and submit the findings from the inquiry done.
- Direct the employer to undertake required actions.

Complaint mechanism

After understanding the functioning of the ICC a complaint can be filed by the aggrieved woman against sexual harassment at the workplace. There is a linear complaint mechanism through which the complaints get filed and the ICC performs its functions, thereby required actions are taken.

- The complainant is supposed to file the complaint in writing and submit the same before the ICC within three months of the date of the incident or the series of incidents in which the last one happened. The Chairperson is empowered to obtain the complaint in writing by providing all assistance to the complainant.
- 2. The committee can also extend the time limit to more than three months for filing the complaint in writing, only if it is satisfied by the circumstances due to which it might not be possible for the complainant to do the same within the said period.
- 3. The complainant can also send the complaint to any committee member via email.
- 4. Filing of a written complaint is mandatory which should include full name with other necessary details of the incident(s) of sexual harassment.
- 5. In case the complainant is not able to file a complaint by herself, her legal heirs, spouse, or parents can file the same.
- 6. A third person can also be the complainant provided that a written complaint must be filed by the one who has been subject to sexual harassment.
