Introduction

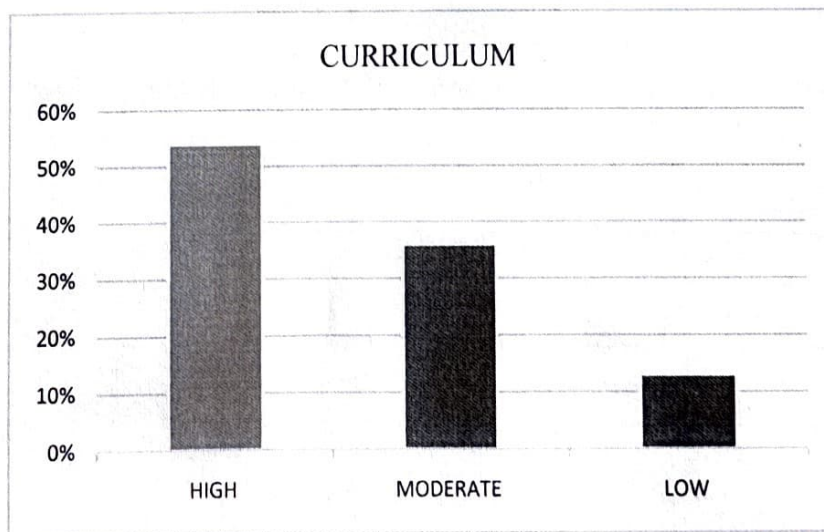

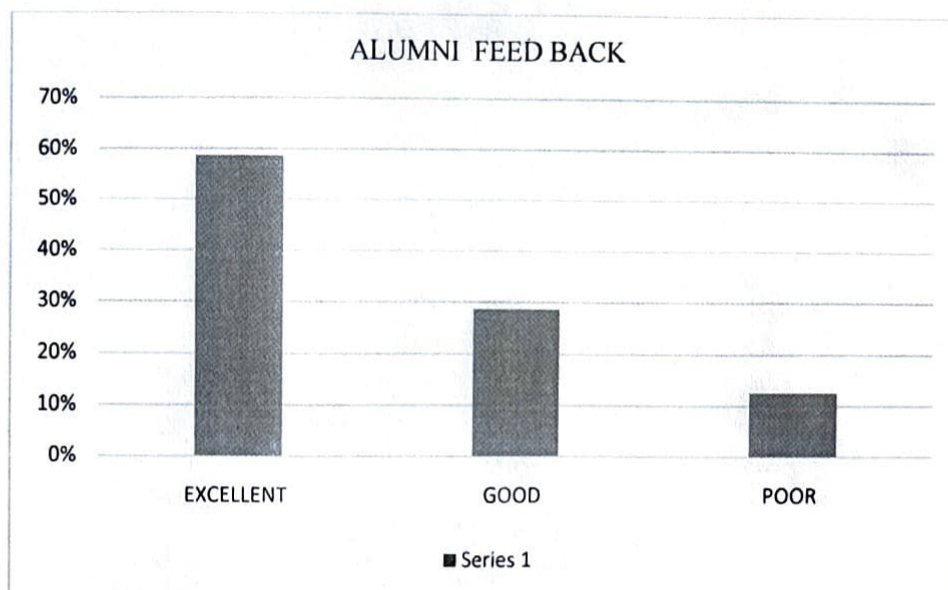
Feedback from Alumni




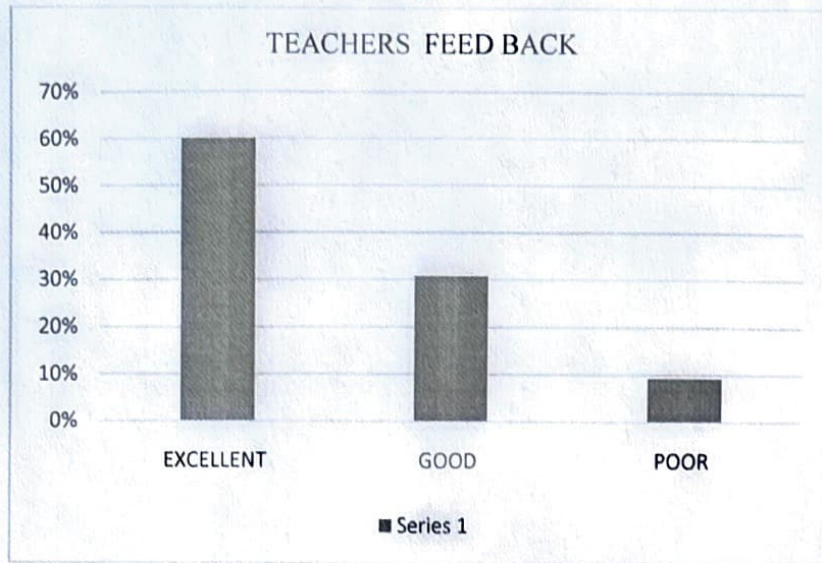
TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM
