Brainstorming:

Brainstorming is a group creativity technique that is often used to find a solution to a specific problem. This is accomplished by gathering and recording new ideas from team members in a free-flowing manner. Brainstorming sessions are usually made up of a handful of core team members, and typically are led by a director or facilitator.

Palm-Sized PCs to Open-Source OS Communities is an important topic in Operating Systems. The activity of group discussion makes it easier to learn the topic of Palm-Sized PCs to Open-Source OS Communities. It helps the students to get a comprehensive knowledge on this topic. Students think individually and share their ideas with their classmates, which improves creative thinking and oral communication skills

Details of the Implementation:
