Minutes of meeting of Board of Studies, Dept of Basic Sciences & Humanities (NSS/NCC/Scouts & Guides /Community service, Health and wellness, yoga and sports) held on 23-07-2024 at 12:30 P.M with the following Resolutions:

At the outset, the principal of DNRCEET presented his gratitude to the university nominee and other members of BOS and handed over the session to the chairman of BOS.

1. Resolutions-1: Introduction of members

The BOS members expressed their appreciation for novel structure of curriculum and content of the course. The chairman of BOS placed the agenda for the deliberation of the members. The following deliberations were made as per the items of circular agenda..

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Resolutions-2: To discuss and finalize the proposed Syllabus for I B. Tech. I&II Semester NSS/NCC/Scouts & Guides /Community service, Health and wellness, yoga and sports courses of DR-24 Regulations

Resolved the proposed I B. Tech I & II Semester (UG) NSS/NCC/Scouts & Guides /Community service, Health and wellness, yoga and sports course under the DR-24 Regulations were discussed in detail. After considering the inputs from all members, the courses were finalized and approved for implementation from the academic year 2024-25.

Resolutions-3: To finalize the Evaluation procedure for Semester End Evaluation (SEE) for NSS/NCC/Scouts & Guides /Community service, Health and wellness, yoga and sport activities

The evolution procedures for Semester End Evolution (SEE) were discussed and finalized. The above said B.Tech programs were evaluated for 100 marks A student must select 6 activities of his/her choice with a minimum of 01 activity per unit. For each activity shall be evaluated by the concerned teacher /instructor for 15 marks, totaling to 90 marks. The remaining 10 marks shall be evaluated by the other college NSS PO (external examiner) / senior faculty by conducting viva voce on above said program. As per suggestion give by university subject expert, the course instructor has to conduct written examination for physical challenged persons (divyangs) for the evolution of the student

Resolution-4: Ratification of Course Objectives and Course Outcomes, CO – PO Mapping for the Proposed Subjects.

Resolved the Course Objectives and Course Outcomes for the proposed subjects were reviewed and ratified. Additionally, the CO-PO mapping was discussed and approved, ensuring alignment with the educational goals of the program.

Resolutions-5: Any other item with the permission of the chairman

Dr Shyam Kumar, Programme Coordinator, NSS JNTU-K has given some suggestions

- NSS course should be taught as real time activities but not as a classroom teaching. This course has been made as a credit based course in the university to create awareness among engineering students to face real life problems. Instructors must train the students to be mentally tough and understand the needs of these skills.
- Course instructors must identify 6-10 parameters from each unit and set a criteria point from each unit. Students must be assessed based on the criteria. Course Instructors must be guided on the parameters setting and evaluation process.
- He advised students of NSS units should work in reality and understand the true essence of serving rather than focusing on taking pictures and uploading
- Technological University colleges should plan for relevance activities when they are in 7 days camp. The aim of the camp is to create awareness among the villagers or farmers in agriculture about the importance of technology usage in their tasks. Example drone usage in insecticides spreading

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
